Organizational aspects

- Accommodation and 3 meals/day are fully covered; the participants will be hosted in a students dorm with a medium confort. Each room will have 2-4 beds. The bathroom will be commun for the entire floor.
- ★ Free wireless internet at the accommodation place;
- ★ Air conditioning is not available.
- ★ Activities materials are fully covered;
- ★ Travel costs are covered based on the travel band distance calculator (the amount is the maximum to be reimbursed for a two way travel). The reimbursement will be made based on the invoices/tickets and boarding-pass in the sending association/group leader account.
- → 360 euros/ participant for Jordan and Georgia;
- → 275 euros/ participant for Macedonia;
- ★ Visa costs:
- → 100 euros/participant visa fee (for Jordan and Georgia);
- → 60 euros/participant visa fee (for Macedonia);
- The health insurance is mandatory for all the participants, but it is not covered by the program, it is considered their co-finance to the project.

You will be staying in Craiova, Romania's 6th largest city and capital of Dolj County, is situated near the east bank of the river Jiu in central Oltenia. It is a longstanding political center, and is located at approximately equal distances from the Southern Carpathians (north) and the River Danube (south). Craiova is the chief commercial city west of Bucharest and the most important city of Oltenia. The city prospered as a regional trading centre despite an earthquake in 1790, a plague in 1795, and a Turkish assault in 1802 during which it was burned.
